1. Public Comment
2. Facility Use (City & School District)
 - a. **City staff explained the benefits of the 2015 agreement and the proposed termination of the other contracts to avoid confusion. Next step is for City Staff to schedule a meeting between the City and the District.**
3. Pittsburg Plays! (City)
 - a. **City staff explained the premise is to receive the grant funds to subsidize the organization so that they may rent facilities controlled by the districts. The Pittsburg Unified School District was asked for a letter of support. The other districts will also be asked for a letter of support**
4. Shimonoseki Sister City (City & School District)
 - a. **City staff explained that the Japanese delegation would like to visit from July 21, 2025 to August 24, 2025. Eight (8) students will be in the cohort, so four (4) hosts need to be identified by July 2025. City staff will reach out the high school's principal directly.**
5. Senate Bill 937 (School District)



- a. City agreed that no permits will be issued until District confirms payment.**
6. Project Updates (City)
 - a. City staff reviewed a few projects, a continuation of earlier conversation with District staff.**
7. School Resource Officer (SRO) - (City)
 - a. Pittsburg Police Captain showed a photo of new Police Dept vehicles as part of an awareness campaign related to fentanyl. District Superintendent noted that graduation is on June 6, 2025 in the evening. The district will be more vigilant about performing restroom sweeps to reduce vaping. There will be an awareness meeting on April 7, 2025 at Heights. Pittsburg Police Dept and District work well in addressing weapons on campus. There is also an app for reporting.**
8. Pedestrian Safety and Traffic Flow / Street Safety Program (City & School District)
 - a. New City Public Works staff is being brought up to speed and meeting will resume in May.**
9. PUSD and City Announcements
 - a. March 31, 2025 – City offices closed for Cesar Chavez Day**
 - b. April 23 & 26, 2025 – City is holding Town Hall (Neighborhood Improvement Team)**
10. Non-Agenda Items
 - a. Councilmember Lopez wants the District to look into a program that will provide grant funds to the district providing rides to students to and from school. District Superintendent will look into it – District already has some other programs for rides.**
